



TSCP LLC – Website Privacy Notice

TSCP LLC (“TSCP”) respects your privacy. This Privacy Notice explains how we collect, use, disclose, and protect personal information when you visit our website or interact with us online. It is intended to be consistent with applicable privacy laws, including the EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), the UK GDPR, and certain U.S. state laws (such as the California Consumer Privacy Act (CCPA), as amended by the CPRA), where they apply.

By using our website, you agree to the practices described in this Notice.

1. Who we are & scope

TSCP LLC is a Delaware, USA company providing cybersecurity, Public Key Infrastructure (PKI) based trusted transactions, and other related trust and compliance services. For GDPR/UK GDPR purposes, TSCP LLC is the data controller for personal information collected via this website.

This Notice covers personal information we collect when you:

- Contact us (e.g., via web form or email); or
- Sign up to receive communications, such as updates or event invitations.

If you are a customer or partner, additional privacy and security terms may appear in your written agreement with TSCP; those terms will control if they conflict with this Notice.

2. Information we collect

We may collect:

Information you provide directly

- Business contact details (name, role, organization, email, phone);
- Content of your communications (questions, support requests, feedback);
- Marketing or communication preferences.

Information collected automatically

When you visit our site, we and our service providers may collect:

- Technical data (IP address, browser type, device/OS identifiers);
- Usage data (pages viewed, links clicked, date/time of visits, referring URL);
- Approximate location based on your IP address.

We may use cookies and similar technologies for site operation, security, and analytics. You can adjust your browser settings to limit cookies, though some features may not work properly.



Information from third parties

We may receive business contact information from partners, event hosts, or publicly available sources (for example, if you register for a joint webinar or industry event) so that we can follow up about TSCP services. We may also receive information from your employer or organizations with which you have a business relationship. This policy only covers information residing on TSCP LLC servers and does not include information on third party sites.

3. How we use your information & legal bases

We use personal information to:

- Operate, maintain, and improve our website and services;
- Respond to inquiries, support requests, and other communications;
- Send service, security, and administrative messages;
- Send marketing or event communications (where permitted by law and your preferences);
- Protect our systems and prevent fraud, abuse, or security incidents;
- Comply with legal and regulatory obligations.

Under GDPR/UK GDPR, we process personal information based on:

- **Performance of a contract** (e.g., providing requested information or services);
- **Legitimate interests** (e.g., improving services, securing our systems, communicating with you as a business contact), balanced against your interests and rights;
- **Consent** (e.g., certain cookies or marketing when consent is required by law); and
- **Legal obligations** (e.g., recordkeeping, responding to lawful requests).

Under U.S. state laws such as CCPA/CPRA, we process personal information for “business purposes,” including website operation, security, analytics, and communications.

4. How we share information

We do **not** sell or share your personal information for cross-context behavioral advertising.

We may disclose personal information:

- To **service providers** who help us operate the website, send communications, provide analytics, or deliver security and IT services, under contracts that restrict their use of the information;
- To **partners or event co-hosts** when you register for joint events or ask to be contacted in connection with their offerings;

- To **affiliates or successors** in connection with a reorganization, merger, or sale of assets; and
- To **public authorities, regulators, or other third parties** where required by law, to protect our rights or the rights and safety of others, or to detect and respond to security or fraud issues.

5. International data transfers

TSCP operates in the United States, and your information may be processed there and in other countries where we or our service providers operate. Where required, we implement appropriate safeguards for cross-border transfers (such as standard contractual clauses or equivalent mechanisms).

6. Data security & retention

We use reasonable technical and organizational measures designed to protect personal information from accidental or unlawful destruction, loss, alteration, or unauthorized access or disclosure.

We retain personal information only for as long as needed for the purposes described in this Notice, to meet legal, regulatory, or contractual requirements, or to resolve disputes.

7. Your privacy rights

Depending on where you live, you may have some or all of the following rights:

- To access and receive a copy of your personal information;
- To correct or update inaccurate information;
- To request deletion of your information;
- To object to or restrict certain processing;
- To withdraw consent where processing is based on consent (without affecting prior processing); and
- To receive your information in a portable format where required by law.

Additional rights for EEA/UK residents (GDPR/UK GDPR)

You may also have the right to:

- Object to processing based on our legitimate interests;
- Lodge a complaint with your local data protection authority; and
- Request information about safeguards used for international transfers.

Additional rights for California and other U.S. state residents (e.g., CCPA/CPRA)

Where these laws apply, you may also have the right to:



- Request to know the categories and specific pieces of personal information we have collected about you, the categories of sources, business purposes, and the categories of third parties with whom we share it;
- Request correction of inaccurate personal information;
- Request deletion of personal information, subject to legal exceptions;
- Opt out of the sale or sharing of personal information (we do not currently sell or share personal information as those terms are defined under CCPA/CPRA); and
- Not be discriminated against for exercising your privacy rights.

To exercise any of these rights, or to submit a privacy request, contact us using the details below. We may need to verify your identity before responding, and will respond within the timelines required by applicable law.
